The **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults** is a program for people who are considering becoming Catholic and for others interested in learning more about the Catholic Church. Meetings are scheduled for most Wednesday evenings from 6:45pm until 8:00pm beginning September 16th, 2009. Dinner is served at 6:00pm and childcare is provided.

Sessions include a presentation about some aspect of the Catholic faith with questions and discussion. The Rites of Initiation will take place at the Easter Vigil service on Saturday, April 3, 2010.

RCIA provides an opportunity for persons to discern, in a no-pressure environment, whether or not they should become members of the Catholic Church. It also offers baptized Catholics who desire more knowledge about the fundamentals of Catholic beliefs and opportunity for renewal of commitment to the faith.
